Additionally, we award the Lois A. Thomas Newspaper Adviser of the Year, named for Thomas, a retired journalism teacher and publications adviser at Putnam City High School in Oklahoma City. This award recognizes excellence in scholastic media advising and service to the field.

*Laura Schaub served as the OIPA (now known as OSM) director from 1991-2003 and continues to support the organization in a variety of ways. She has a long history teaching publications design, which she continues in her position with the Lifetouch yearbook company.

**On July 30, 2018, OSM lost a great friend and educator, Karen Beavers, who passed away in her home. Karen had just begun retirement after spending many years as a teacher and publications adviser at Lawton High School. She was incredibly adept at nurturing student leaders, and for this reason, OSM named this award for her.


